2. Purpose of this privacy notice

This privacy notice describes how Liikesivistysrahaston Kannatusyhdistys ry (later “LSR” or “we”) processes the personal data of the categories of data subjects listed in section 3 and what rights data subjects have.

3. Categories of data subjects

Data subjects include

- grant applicants and recipients, and possible providers of recommendations/statements
 - members
 - representatives of partners and stakeholders (e.g. contact persons, representatives of educational institutions, providers of grant-related statements, asset managers, representatives of goods and service providers and other contractual partners, and contacts related to special funds, donations and bequests)
 - newsletter subscribers
 - website visitors
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4. Purposes of processing, legal bases and categories of personal data

In the table below you can find what personal data we process and the purposes and legal bases for the processing.

5. Sources of personal data

Personal data is primarily collected from the data subject. In addition, data is collected as follows:

- Data contained in an external statement may be collected at the request of the grant applicant.
- Authorised employees of Liikesivistysrahasto process and store data related to the administrative processing, granting decisions and payment of grants.
- Data relating to representatives of partners and stakeholders is obtained from the cooperation organisation or from public sources such as organisations' websites.
- IT systems collect data on users and the use of systems.

6. Recipients of personal data and data transfers outside of the EU/EEA

We may disclose personal data to other controllers for the following purposes:

- To authorities and pension institutions where required by law
- To partners and stakeholders (such as educational institutions involved in the application, award or other processing of grants)
- To funders, where data is exchanged with other funding bodies to ensure an overall view of funding and to avoid overlapping awards
- To other necessary parties, such as banks for payments, insurance companies, debt collection agencies, enforcement authorities and auditors

Information on awarded grants is published in LSR's annual report and on the website, www.lsr.fi. (A grant recipient may request that their name is not published on the website.)

Personal data is processed by our service providers, who assist with our operations (e.g. IT, financial administration, grant management system). To ensure high level of protection and confidentiality of your personal data, we have a data processing agreement with all service

providers involved in the processing of personal data. Our service providers do not have the permission to process your information in any ways beyond the agreed services

As a rule, personal data is not transferred outside the EU or EEA. If transfers are made, they are carried out using safeguards in accordance with EU data protection legislation (such as the European Commission's standard contractual clauses and adequacy decisions).

7. Retention times of personal data

We have determined retention periods based on the purpose of the processing and the applicable legislation. We review the personal data we collect regularly to ensure that the personal data we have is up to date and is not retained longer than needed or required by the relevant laws.

8. Data subject rights

Under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), a data subject has the right to:

- receive information about the processing of their personal data
- access their own data
- request rectification of data
- request erasure of data
- restrict processing
- object to processing
- data portability (under certain conditions)
- withdraw consent at any time

A data subject also has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority. In Finland, this is the Office of the Data Protection Ombudsman, <https://tietosuoja.fi/>.

9. Automated decision-making and profiling

LSR does not carry out automated decision-making or profiling based on personal data that would have significant effects on the data subject.

10. Protection of personal data

LSR and its selected service providers use appropriate physical, technical and administrative safeguards to protect data against misuse.

Personal data is protected by appropriate technical and organisational measures, such as restriction of access rights, personal user IDs, firewalls and information security systems, physical access control, staff instructions and confidentiality. Paper records are stored in a locked and access-controlled space.

Personal data is processed only by persons who are entitled to process based on their work duties.

11. Personal data breaches

Any personal data breaches are reported to the competent supervisory authority and, where necessary, to the data subject within the time limits required by law.

12. Use of cookies

13. Updates to the privacy notice
